Because of all the past Treasurers and their continuous work to keep our Chapter on budget and running smoothly, Noralee presented me with a large container with all of our banking and Chapter records. Some records need to be kept forever and others have a life span of 7 years. Basically, any monetary transaction and communication about dues to International and State is recorded and neatly filed. Because of this, my job will be to continue this accurate accounting of all the finances of our Chapter.

The other task Noralee helped me to learn is accessing the dues portal and all things needed to do my job as Treasurer on the International and State website. Fortunately, there are tutorials put together to guide me as I learn my responsibilities. In June, I attended a treasurer's workshop down in Columbus. Diana Haskell who is the State Treasurer, provided all the current Treasurers valuable information to help us with our job. There is an amazing level of accountability from our Chapter to State to International, and I am in the process of learning all the forms to be completed and who gets a copy. We would like to thank Noralee Starr for her dedication to the job of treasurer for the Gamma Theta Chapter these past two years. Noralee kept accurate records with a monthly accounting of how Chapter funds were being dispersed. She worked alongside the Finance Committee providing us with all documentation and was transparent with all monies in the three Chapter Funds. This is a laborious job given the three funds reside in one account, plus doing this while teaching full time under very unusual circumstances.

The Chapter books for 2021-2022 are closed and ready for Annie to assume the Treasurer's job for 2022-2023. Noralee has made arrangements to meet with Annie and hand over all Treasurer materials to her.

As the Executive Board is meeting this summer and making plans, it might be beneficial to know the amounts of money in each fund:

* I am currently collecting checks for the Gamma Theta Scholarship Fund from Jim Howell, as he receives donations in memory of Paulette. So far there is an additional \$365.00 to be added into that account. Jim is currently gone for a few weeks, and I know there will be more donations waiting when he returns. I will turn all of the checks over to Annie as soon as I receive them.

**These are the monies that can be used for programs, postage, or to meet any needs of the Chapter and the Officers attending conferences etc. We always maintain a carryover balance from year to year so as not to become financially strapped as a Chapter.

On a final note, please remember that you must request a voucher from the finance committee BEFORE spending any money. Annie can NOT write a check without a signed voucher from finance and a receipt for the purchase.

We want to wish the new Executive Board a very successful term!


